

Top Expeditions and Cruises for 2024

ver wondered what lies beyond the beaten path? Brace yourself as we unveil the most daring and luxurious expeditions for 2024. From the secrets of Melanesia to the icy majesty of Greenland and the paradisiacal wonders of Komodo National Park, these journeys are invitations to redefine exploration.





EYOS Expeditions, the world leader in private superyacht expedition charters, is launching its first season-long expedition charters in Melanesia, from May to September 2024. This is one of the first times an international superyacht will be based in the region for a full summer season. Melanesia is one of the least explored places on earth, but its rich culture and natural beauty make it a dream destination for travellers seeking unique and authentic experiences.

Papua New Guinea is a land of unparalleled beauty and diversity, home to over 850 languages and cultures. Led by experienced expedition leaders like Angela Pennefather, who was born and raised in Papua New Guinea, guests will explore WWII shipwrecks, witness sacred rituals and ancient rites of passage, and encounter the incredible diversity of the islands and their aquatic ecosystems. On private charters, guests can craft a fully bespoke itinerary, choosing from snorkelling and diving in Kimbe Bay, witnessing the fiery eruptions of volcanoes in Vanuatu, and attending a sing-sing gathering in Papua New Guinea. For those wanting deeper immersion in Papua New Guinea, there is the opportunity to head out on an air safari, overnight, in Mt. Hagen, located in the heart of the Highlands.

Your EYOS 11-day expedition to Papua New Guinea will begin in Rabaul, where you will board your private yacht and settle into your new home. One of the highlights of this expedition is a visit to the Baining Mountains to witness the remarkable Baining Fire Dance, an ancient ritual performed by young Baining men as an initiation into adulthood. Another highlight is a visit to Witu Island, a





flooded caldera that is home to a unique culture. It's a once-in-a-lifetime chance to meet local people, learn about their culture, and take part in ceremonial performances.

EYOS can arrange full private charters, but expeditions to Papua New Guinea, Komodo, and some others can be booked by the cabin. This means that you can have the same great experience as on a full charter with the flexibility of booking by cabin and at a fraction of the cost.
